Registration

Step 1


Please go to https://voting.institutionalinvestor.com
If you are a first-time user, please sign up with your professional email address using the link at the top right corner. An email will be sent to verify your account.

Step 2

If you are not in the *Institutional Investor* database as an eligible voter, you may request a ballot after signing up and verifying your email address.

Step 3

You will be asked to fill out information about your company and job title. Requests will be reviewed to determine eligibility. If approved, you will be able to see the survey under "My Surveys".



Voting Instructions (1 of 3)

Step 1

Once you have completed registration (instructions on previous slide) or already have an account, navigate to "My Surveys" and select the "All-America & All-Canada Survey 2023 Ballot."





Step 2*

Please select the desired sector to vote for an analyst. You can either a) select the parent sector or b) search for the analyst name, which will skip you straight to step 5 in our voting guide. If multiple selections appear, hover over the display rows to choose which category to vote for.



*If all surveys are greyed out except for "CEO, CFO & Investor Relations", it means you are required to cast a vote in the CEO, CFO & Investor Relations survey; instructions on how to do so may be found in the appendix of this document.

Step 3

Select the category (sub sector) you would like to vote for.

Step 4

Type "BofA" and hit enter.

Step 6





Voting in the CEO, CFO & Investor Relations Survey




CEO, CFO & Investor Relations Survey (1 of 2)

Follow the steps below to cast your ballot in this survey required for equity voters*


Step 1

Once you have completed registration (instructions on page 2) or if you already have an account, navigate to "My Surveys" and select "All-America & All-Canada Survey 2023 Ballot."



Step 2

If your screen does not default to the survey, please select the "CEO, CFO & Investor Relations (US & Canada)" survey; you will then be brought to step 3 " Firm" on the survey and the next page.



*Required in 2023

Survey respondents are asked to submit feedback for company executive teams and Investor Relations ("IR") professionals at each company they nominate. Il requires a submission on the CEO, CFO & Investor Relations (US & Canada) Survey to vote in "Research" surveys.

To fulfill the requirements, respondents must nominate:


at least one publicly listed company and rate on its IR attributes (out of five stars)
 at least one IR officer's performance before the research ballot will be made available

Step 3


Search for a company that you follow or have frequent interactions with. In this example, we will vote for a sample "COMPANY ABC".



Step 4

Provide feedback in all categories under the company tab.
